As a recipient of the Global Excellence Scholarship, I was fortunate to experience summer in Spain during my summer school exchange programme this year. Coming from a disadvantaged background, traveling outside of Southeast Asia had always been a distant dream that I thought I would only be able to fulfil when I was much older. However, the opportunity to attend summer school in Spain arose, and I knew I could not let it pass by. I was delighted to learn that the scholarship covers up to \$5000 for overseas travel expenses in addition to the programme fees. This support enabled me to immerse myself in the life of an international student in Spain for a month, broadening my perspective on cultural enrichment, European history, and allowing me to make friends from different countries. I also had the chance to go on road trips to the countryside on weekends and even flew to Portugal for a short visit.

Beyond the incredible experience of visiting a country I had never imagined being able to explore, the scholarship significantly relieved a financial burden, allowing me to focus entirely on my academics without the need for part-time work to cover school fees and living expenses.
