

LIM DOA HIN SCHOLARSHIP (FULL-TIME UNDERGRADUATES)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Lim Doa Hin Scholarship is open to incoming full-time undergraduates preferably pursuing the Bachelor of Arts in Chinese Studies, Bachelor of Early Childhood or Bachelor of Social Work programme. Other full-time programmes may be considered.
2. Applicants must be Singapore Citizens with outstanding academic records, active participation in co-curricular activities, possess strong language skills, and demonstrate leadership qualities.
3. Applicants should preferably be involved in community projects in key areas of needs within or beyond SUSS.
4. The scholarship is valued at S\$7,500 and will support recipient for the following academic year (2 semesters).
5. This scholarship is to be awarded on an annual basis, and eligible students have to apply for it annually.
6. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with the University.
7. Recipients may not hold any other scholarship, fellowship, award or allowance concurrently without prior approval from the University.
8. Recipients are required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the respective programme. In addition, scholars must have good conduct and **maintain a cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.8** to re-apply for the scholarship.
9. **Recipients will be required to take part in university activities/events, and community involvement projects as deemed appropriate and/or directed by the University.**
10. Scholarship application must be submitted online by the stipulated deadline, together with all relevant supporting documents. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend an interview. **The decision of the University on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.**
11. The University reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct and/or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
12. The University reserves the right to amend the above terms and conditions at its sole discretion without prior notice.

13. Recipients to refer to SUSS website for the latest terms and conditions published for the scholarship.

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful scholarship candidates.
