

KWAN IM THONG HOOD CHO TEMPLE SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The scholarship is open to **graduate students taking at least 2 relevant courses in non-profit management, community leadership and social development.**
2. Applicant must possess outstanding academic results, strong language skills, active participation in co-curricular activities and community service, and demonstrate leadership qualities.
3. Each award is S\$15,000 and will be used to offset the tuition fees throughout the recipient's remaining candidature of study.
4. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with the University. They may not concurrently hold any other scholarship, fellowship, award or allowance without prior approval from the University.
5. Recipients are required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the programme. In addition, scholars must have good conduct and **maintain a cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.8** for the continuation of the scholarship award.
6. **Recipients are required to take part in university's activities/events, and community involvement projects as deemed appropriate and/or directed by the University.**
7. Scholarship application must be submitted online by the stipulated deadline, together with all relevant supporting documents. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend an interview. **The decision of the University on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.**
8. The University reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
9. The University reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions at its sole discretion without prior notice.
10. **Recipients are required to refer to SUSS website for the latest terms and conditions published for the scholarship.**

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful applicants.
