We are now inviting applications for the Graduate Certificate in Non-Profit Management for the July 2019 intake.

Applicants may choose to attend individual module/s only. If you complete all the academic requirements and pass the assessments of all 3 modules, you may apply for Graduate Certificate in Non-Profit Management. Otherwise, you will receive a course certificate upon completion of the module if you attend individual module.

These course are suitable for those in the non-profit organisations wanting to pick up new knowledge and skill sets. It is also meant for those who work involve Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) or for anyone who wants to know more about the non-profit sector especially on how to manage volunteers as well as understanding the broad framework on governance and aspects of fundraising.

The courses are mapped to the skills framework for Social Service and is approved for subsidy under the Skills-Future series.

If you complete all the academic requirements and pass the assessments of all 3 modules, you may apply for Graduate Diploma in Non-Profit Management (for those that have obtained the Graduate Certificate earlier) or Course Certificate upon completion of an individual module.

Course & Assessment

Most modules will conducted from 8.30am to 5.30pm for 4 Consecutive Saturdays. The continuous assessments will consist of pre-course quizzes, individual and/or group assignments and either a final term paper or a final exam.
