

THE KWAN IM THONG HOOD CHO TEMPLE SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The scholarship is open to applicants who wish to enrol in the **Graduate Diploma in**Non- Profit Management, Graduate Diploma in Community Leadership and
 Social Development, Master of Management (specialising in Non-Profit
 Management).
- 2. Applicant must be a new student (Singapore citizen or Permanent resident) with outstanding academic results, possess strong language skills, an impressive track record in co-curricular activities, demonstrable leadership qualities, and exhibit zest for involvement in community service.
- 3. The value of each scholarship covers 100% of the total course fee, capped at \$15,000.
- 4. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS).
- 5. Recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the scholarship.
- 6. Prospective students must separately seek admission to the programme and must be accepted for admission before being awarded the scholarship.
- 7. The scholarship may not, without the prior approval of SUSS, be held concurrently with any other awards.
- 8. The recipient is required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the programme. In addition, the recipient must **maintain at least a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.8** for the continuation of the scholarship.
- 9. Recipients will be required to take part in university's activities/events, and community involvement projects as deemed appropriate and/or directed by the University.
- 10. SUSS reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.

- 11. SUSS reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the scholarship award at its sole discretion.
- 12. Each application must be accompanied by the following supporting documents:
 - ➤ A statement of Purpose for applying to the programme
 - ➤ At least two letters of support from referees
- 13. Shortlisted applicants will be notified to attend an interview by end May for July semester and end October for January semester.
- 14. The decision of SUSS on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful applicants.
