

SUSS-SOCIAL RESILIENCE ENHANCEMENT FUND SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The scholarship is open to students from the Master of Counselling, Master of Gerontology, Master of Social Work, Master of Early Childhood Education, Master of Adult Learning, and Master of Management (specialising in Non-Profit Management).
- 2. Applicants must be Singapore citizens or permanent residents with good academic and co-curricular activities record, possess strong language skills and demonstrate leadership qualities.
- 3. The value of each scholarship covers 100% of the total course fee, capped at \$10,000.
- 4. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS).
- 5. Applicants must meet the admission requirements for the programme. Prospective students must separately seek admission to the programme and must be accepted for admission before being awarded the scholarship.
- 6. Prospective students are required to complete the online Admission Application, including the submission of all supporting documents and a non-refundable application fee paid to the University.
- 7. The scholarship may not, without the prior approval of the SUSS, be held concurrently with any other awards.
- 8. The recipient is required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the programme. In addition, the recipient must **maintain at least a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.8** for the continuation of the scholarship award.
- 9. Recipients will be required to take part in university's activities/events, and community involvement projects as deemed appropriate and/or directed by the University.
- 10. SUSS reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
- 11. SUSS reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the scholarship award at its sole discretion.

- 12. Shortlisted applicants will be notified to attend an interview by end May for July semester and end October for January semester.
- 13. The decision of SUSS on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.
