

WONG LAN ENG SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Scholarship is open to all new and continuing students in the **Master of Management (Non-Profit Management) programme**.
- 2. Applicant must be a Singapore citizen or Permanent resident with outstanding academic results, possess strong language skills, an impressive track record in co-curricular activities, demonstrable leadership qualities, and exhibit zest for involvement in community service.
- 3. The scholarship is valued at \$7,400 per year for 2 years i.e., up to total of \$14,800.
- 4. Scholarship recipients are not required to serve a bond with Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS).
- 5. Recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the scholarship.
- 6. Prospective students must separately seek admission to the programme and must be accepted for admission before being awarded the scholarship.
- 7. The scholarship may not, without the prior approval of SUSS, be held concurrently with any other awards.
- 8. The recipient is required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the programme. In addition, the recipient must **maintain at least a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.8** for the continuation of the scholarship.
- 9. Recipients will be required to take part in university's activities/events, and community involvement projects as deemed appropriate and/or directed by the University.
- 10. SUSS reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the scholarship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
- 11. SUSS reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the scholarship award at its sole discretion.
- 12. Shortlisted applicants will be notified to attend an interview by end May for July semester and end October for January semester.
- 13. The decision of SUSS on the selection of scholarship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.
