

## **Temasek Foundation Study Award** **(For Part-Time Undergraduate Students)**

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. The Temasek Foundation Study Award is open to all Singapore Citizens who are receiving government subsidy for their tuition fees, and are new applicants enrolling for the academic year 2022 and 2023 (current students may be considered on a case-to-case basis).
2. Applicant must be pursuing the Counselling, Psychology or Social Work undergraduate programme
3. Recipients will have up to 4.5 years to complete their undergraduate programme.
4. Preference will be given to:
  - Applicants who are mid-career switchers
  - Applicants in the mental health sector seeking to upgrade themselves.
  - Applicants with leadership, volunteering and community service experience.
5. The study awards will cover the tuition fees of awardees. The award amount will be nett of the MOE Higher Education Bursary (HEB), for students who have been awarded both the HEB and this Study Award.
6. Shortlisted candidates will be notified to attend an interview.
7. The value of the Study Award covers 100% (inclusive of government subsidy) of the total course fee.
8. Recipients will be required to reimburse the study award amount if they fail to complete their part-time undergraduate programmes.
9. Study award recipients will be asked and expected to take part in activities/events, community involvement projects and/or be featured on the university's collaterals as deemed appropriate by the University.
10. Applicants must meet the admission requirements for the applied course of study. Prospective students must separately seek admission to the programme and must be accepted for admission before being awarded the study award.
11. Prospective students must separately submit the online Admission Application with supporting documents and \$64.20 (inclusive of GST) application fee (non-refundable) to the University.
12. The study award may not, without the prior approval of SUSS, be held concurrently with any other awards.
13. The decision of the University on the selection of study award candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.
14. SUSS reserves the right to revoke the study award at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
15. SUSS reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions for the study award at its sole discretion.
16. Applicants are required to submit their supporting documents together with the study award e-application. Otherwise, the application would be considered incomplete and will not be processed.
17. Study awards application for **January semester/July semester** must be submitted by **15 September/15 March** respectively. Recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the study award.
