

SUSS-STTA SPORTS LEADER SPONSORSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Sponsorship is open to new and current SUSS students pursuing part-time undergraduate programmes, Bachelor of Laws, or graduate programmes (Master's, PhD and Doctoral programmes only).
- 2. The Sponsorship is open to Singapore Citizen and Singapore Permanent Resident athletes nominated by the Singapore Table Tennis Association (STTA).
- 3. Applicants must have good academic and co-curricular records, strong language skills and demonstrate leadership qualities.
- 4. Nominated applicants must fulfil the selection criteria set by SUSS and STTA. They must meet the admission requirements for the applied course of study.
- 5. Applicants who are currently applying for admission to the part-time undergraduate programmes (or existing undergraduates) must not already be degree holders.
- 6. The Sponsorship covers course fees for the entire programme of study, up to the values indicated below:

- 7. This sponsorship may not, without the prior approval of SUSS, be held concurrently with any other Scholarship or Sponsorship award.
- 8. The recipient is required to sit for all examinations, complete the programme within the prescribed time and conform to regulations, instructions and discipline in force for the respective programme. In addition, for continuation of the sponsorship, the recipient is required to maintain at least a Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 for part-time undergraduate programmes, or a CGPA of 3.5 for the Bachelor of Laws, or a CGPA of 3.8 for graduate programmes.
- 9. Successful recipients are required to sign a sponsorship agreement with SUSS, and have to conform to the terms and conditions spelt out in the Sponsorship agreement. SUSS and STTA reserve the right to amend the terms and conditions for the Sponsorship award at their sole discretion without prior notice.
- 10. SUSS reserves the right to withdraw or suspend the Sponsorship at any time if, in its opinion, the recipient's conduct or academic performance has not been satisfactory.
- 11. Sponsorship recipients are not required to serve a bond with SUSS or STTA.
- 12. Admission and Sponsorship applications must be submitted by <u>15 September (for January intake)</u> and <u>15 March (for July intake)</u>. Sponsorship recipients are not allowed to request for deferment of the sponsorship award.
- 13. The decision of the SUSS and STTA on the selection of Sponsorship candidates is final and no appeal will be entertained.

A separate letter and agreement with the detailed terms and conditions (including the above terms and conditions) and others relating to the course of study will be given to all successful applicants.
