
At Singapore University of Social Sciences (SUSS), we believe that everyone should have access to a good education and prospects for a better future at every stage of life.

APPLIED LINGUISTICS (TESOL)



The Applied Linguistics (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages, also known as TESOL) programme is an advanced academic Master's degree that gives language teachers the sound theoretical foundation and practical skills needed for language teaching and other related work.

It can cater to your needs, whether you are a teacher from the local school system (Primary to Junior College) or from a tertiary institution and the private sector. The comprehensive nature of the programme suits both experienced and novice language instructors or administrators, as well as professionals in other fields who are considering a mid-career switch.

The specially-designed courses can provide candidates with little or no experience in language teaching with the practical knowledge needed for practice, reflection and theorising. For the more experienced candidates among you, an extensive range of electives allows you to engage in advanced practice and theorising in selected specialised topics for more profound reflection.

The MBA programme prepares aspiring managers with the knowledge and skills that business leaders need to drive and execute initiatives that meet business objectives and organisational excellence. The programme also imparts awareness in learners who will excel professionally while fulfilling requirements in sustainable development, social responsibility and ethical practice. Simply put, it is a programme that grooms you to be managers with a heart and provides you with a learning environment that exposes you to key business concepts that not only meet the needs of today's business environment but also help you adapt to tomorrow's changing corporate landscape.

The curriculum is based on a series of learning blocks: assimilating knowledge progressively through a Core-Function-Area approach, honing managerial and social responsibility skills through an Experiential Project, and a Management Communication course. The programme is conducted over three semesters spanning 18 months. In the first semester, you will learn to manage an organisation. In the second semester, you will learn to run a business. Finally, in the third semester, you will learn to grow the business in a competitive environment.

aster of COUNSELLING

The counselling field has grown in tandem with changes in our society as the population responds to the challenges of Singapore's economic growth and development. To support this change, Singapore University of Social Sciences launched its Bachelor's programme in Counselling (BCOU) in the year 2007, the first of its kind to be offered by a local university. Following that, the introduction of the Master of Counselling (MCOU) programme answers the clarion call for more advanced education at the Master's level, as well as offers robust and systematic training to develop clinically competent professionals in specialised fields such as Couple and Family Therapy (CFT).

UNIQUE features of the PROGRAMME

Emphasises a balance of skill and practice learning as well as academic rigour while allowing specialisation in different areas of counselling including training in supervisory skills.

Offers flexible entry and exit points to suit different academic needs. Bridging courses will help those without prior counselling training to be initiated into the programme.

CFT specialisation is the first in Singapore to provide systematic tertiary-level training to therapists for the mental health sectors.

The programme is recognised and accredited by the Singapore Association for Counselling.

Provides guidance by an industry supervisor, in addition to an academic supervisor, in order to ensure industry relevance.



Evolving societal and community needs, especially those faced by families and couples, have heightened the expectations that the public and employers have of contemporary social workers.

To meet such challenges, leaders in the social services sector are required to play a vital role in guiding and grooming fellow social workers as well as to possess a wealth of knowledge in specific fields. The Master of Social Work (MSWK) programme is a practice-based programme aimed at developing leaders for the social service sector. 



Concession

SUSS offers the following course fee concessions:

1. Applicants who are 60 years old and above will enjoy a 20% course fee concession.
