Programme Overview

In today's rapidly evolving educational landscape, characterised by technological advancements, diverse learning needs, and shifting pedagogical paradigms, the roles of educational professionals are undergoing significant transformation.

The Master of Education (MEd) programme is designed to equip professionals with the knowledge and skills needed to stay current with educational research, innovative teaching approaches, and emerging technologies. It prepares graduates to excel as educators, instructional designers, technology integrators, corporate trainers, leaders in educational and organisational innovation and more.

Key features of the MEd programme:

- **Innovative Curriculum:** Stay ahead with courses that reflect the latest trends, research and practices in education.
- **Flexible Learning Options:** The programme offers three stackable Graduate Diplomas (GD), designed to accommodate working professionals and learners with different needs. One of the GDs follows a work-study format, enabling asynchronous learning for those balancing professional commitments with academic growth.
- **Expert Faculty:** Learn from leading educators and industry experts dedicated to your success.
- **Career Advancement:** Enhance your professional prospects in various educational and learning and development roles.

Whom is this for?

The Master of Education programme is suitable for both local and international educational professionals across various industries.

It caters to educators, corporate trainers, instructional designers, learning and development specialists, curriculum and course developers, as well as learning designers. It is also suitable for individuals seeking a career switch into the education field.

Career Prospects

Graduates of this programme will gain the knowledge and skills needed to advance their careers and take on more impactful roles. In educational institutions, they may progress to senior teaching positions, curriculum development and coordination, or educational consulting. In corporate settings, they may pursue opportunities in training and development, curriculum design, and programme management, focusing on enhancing workforce capabilities and fostering lifelong learning.

Programme Structure

The Master of Education programme consists of three stackable Graduate Diplomas (GD), comprising two foundational GDs – Graduate Diploma in Education (GDED) and Graduate Diploma in Curriculum and Teaching (GDCT) – and one deepening GD – Graduate Diploma in Learning Design and Technology (GDLDT). Students can opt for either the GDED – GDLDT or GDCT – GDLDT route to attain the master's degree. They also have the option to choose a standalone GD without completing a master's degree.

Students are required to complete a total of 60 credit units (CU) with a minimum CGPA of 3.0 to graduate with a Master.

The programme offers both a regular pathway (two to four years, part-time), and an accelerated pathway (one year, full-time), with the accelerated option available only through the GDED-GDLDT route.

² Upon completion of 30 CU of courses, students will need a minimum CGPA of 2.5 to be awarded Graduate Diploma in Curriculum & Teaching.

³ Upon completion of 30 CU of courses, students will need a minimum CGPA of 2.5 to be awarded Graduate Diploma in Learning Design & Technology.

⁴ Upon completion of 60 CU of courses, students will need a minimum CGPA of 3.0 to be awarded Master of Education.

JOIN US

Applicants must possess an undergraduate degree or an equivalent qualification from a recognised institution.

For SUSS graduate programmes that are conducted in the English Language, you must meet the English Language Proficiency Requirement (ELPR)* **if** your undergraduate degree is not awarded by an English-medium university, **or** your undergraduate degree is awarded by an English-medium university but the language of instruction was not English.

** at least an IELTS (Academic) score of 6.5, or a TOEFL score of 580 (paper-based) or 85 (internet-based), or a PTE Academic score of 58, or C1 Advanced score of 180 [score must be obtained within the last 2 years at point of application].*

Applicants with an undergraduate degree that was conducted in English but awarded by a non-English medium university must produce an official letter from the university to certify as such in order to seek waiver of the ELPR requirement.

Some programmes may have additional requirements. Please refer to the individual programme pages for details.

Shortlisted applicants may be required to undergo one or more interviews and/or take written admission or other evaluation tests as may be prescribed by SUSS from time to time.

All applications are considered individually on merit, and the offer of admission is dependent on the number of places available in individual programmes. Admission is solely at the discretion of SUSS and the decision is final and binding. SUSS reserves the right to refuse admission and is not obliged to offer an explanation for the non-admission of unsuccessful candidates.

Applications are to be made online via suss.edu.sg/apply.

You must submit all the required documents together with your admission application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
