

Donation FAQ

1. Why should I make a donation?

Your donation will go towards the SUSS Sustainability Endowment Fund, which supports sustainability scholarships, awards, and student-led projects. These funds are matched by the Singapore Government, which will amplify your impact. Furthermore, donations of \$400 or more will receive a complimentary, not-for-sale and non-transferable pass to the event as a token of appreciation. If you have already registered and paid the registration fee, you are still welcome to donate additionally.

2. How will I receive my complimentary pass?

We will send you a confirmation email with details on how to access your pass. Closer to the event, you will also receive event admission instructions and any relevant updates.

3. Are donations eligible for tax benefits?

Yes. Donations made by Singapore tax residents are eligible for a 250% personal income tax deduction. For organisations that are Singapore tax residents, please provide your UEN so that a tax-deductible receipt can be issued.

4. What kind of receipt will I receive?

If you paid a registration fee, you will receive a tax invoice. For any separate donations made, eligible donors will receive a tax-deductible receipt.

5. Can my organisation make a donation on behalf of attendees?

Yes. If your organisation prefers to make a single consolidated donation, we will extend priority complimentary passes based on the total donation amount. As a general guideline, each \$400 increment entitles the donor to one complimentary pass. Small variations in donation amounts will be considered at our discretion.

6. Can I donate less than \$400?

Yes. While any amount is welcome, only donors who contribute \$400 or more will receive a complimentary pass as a token of appreciation. Capacity permitting, we may also invite donors of smaller amounts to attend.
