Poster Submission and Presentation Guidelines

OVERVIEW

The Poster Presentation session provides participants with an opportunity to present their research-in-progress, receive constructive feedback, and engage with academic and industry experts in sustainability. This session is ideal for students seeking to refine their research and expand their academic and professional networks.

ELIGIBILITY

- Submission is open to all conducting research related to sustainability.
 - The research study related to the topics covered in the conference can be at any stage, from early conceptualisation to near completion.

POSTER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Authors must submit a 300-word abstract on the EasyChair platform following the Abstract Submission Guidelines specified on the SAC2025 website.

Additionally, a draft version of the poster (in PDF format) containing the main information must be uploaded to support the review process.

Requirements for abstracts

1. Indication of track
2. Title
3. Author(s) and affiliation(s) and contact information (email, address)
4. Research objective/problem statement
5. Methodology
6. Key findings and implications
7. Key words: (Max. 5)

Poster design and content requirements:

- Title, author(s), affiliation(s)
- Research problem and objectives
- Key findings and significance
- Visuals such as graphs, tables, or images to support research
- Clear and concise text for readability
- References: APA 7th edition format

Notes:

- Submitted posters must not be formally published elsewhere nor be under current review for publication in any book or publicly accessible conference proceedings. If the submitted work has been previously presented at another conference, symposium, or meeting, authors/presenters must disclose this during submission.
- Authors/presenters are responsible for preparing and printing their own posters. Please ensure that your poster is printed before the conference as the conference committee does not provide printing services.

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- **Poster Size:** A1 (594mm x 841mm) in portrait orientation
 - **Poster Presentations**
 - Posters will be displayed at the conference venue.
 - Authors presenting posters must set up their materials in the designated area and be available during the assigned session for discussions. Refer to the conference programme for the date/time.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) USAGE GUIDELINES

Posters that rely primarily on content generated by Large Language Models (LLMs) such as ChatGPT, without meaningful human authorship, will not be accepted. The use of any LLMs must be documented clearly, specifying the sections in which they were used and the percentage of text generated by the LLM. If AI tools were used to assist with enhancing human-generated text, such as improving readability, style, grammar, spelling, punctuation, or tone, authors must declare this in their submission.
