

SUSS LAW & YOUTH CAMP 2026 (“CAMP”) PARTICIPATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Camp is organised by Singapore University of Social Sciences (“SUSS”).

The One-Day Camp provides a platform for Secondary School students to learn about Singapore’s legal system and fundamental legal concepts through a series of engaging workshops and a quiz competition.

Aims and Objectives

- To introduce students to Singapore’s legal system, general legal concepts, and selected youth-related legal issues.
- To develop analytical and critical thinking, as well as communication and problem-solving skills.
- To foster teamwork and healthy competition by enabling students to collaborate, challenge and showcase their legal knowledge.

BY REGISTERING FOR THIS CAMP, PARTICIPATING OR ATTEMPTING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CAMP AND/OR USING THE CAMP SITE (“Site”), YOU (“you”) ARE AGREEING TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS. THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ARE A LEGALLY BINDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN YOU AND SUSS WITH RESPECT TO THE CAMP.

SUSS will have the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time, which modification will be effective immediately. Accordingly, we suggest that you check our [Event Page](#) periodically. To provide context for your periodic review, we will post a date at the bottom of this document as the initial reference point.

1. Eligibility

- 1.1. You must be a registered Secondary 3, 4 or 5 or IP Year 3 or 4 (or equivalent level) student of a secondary school in Singapore.
- 1.2. You will need a signed consent from your parent/legal guardian for you to participate in the Camp. The Consent Form is available [here](#).
- 1.3. You must find a teacher from your school to assist with participating in this Camp. All participants must be under the supervision of their assigned teacher from their respective school at all times.
- 1.4. Your assigned teacher will sign you up as a part of a team comprising of 3 members (“Team”). One of your Team members will assume the role of a leader. You are not allowed to be on more than one team for this Camp.

2. Registration

- 2.1. Your assigned teacher must register for this Camp by completing the Registration Form available [here](#). Your assigned teacher will warrant that all information provided by you during the registration process are accurate and complete.
- 2.2. The registration will bind your Team members and your assigned teacher to these Terms and Conditions. SUSS may also require each Team member to signify his/her agreement to these Terms and Conditions in a manner required by SUSS.
- 2.3. Your Team may be disqualified from participating in this Camp if:
 - (a) There is any breach of these Terms and Conditions by you or any of your Team;
 - (b) Any information provided during registration is found to be incomplete and/or inaccurate.
- 2.4. There are limited places for this Camp, and registration is on a first come first served basis.
- 2.5. It is the responsibility of your Team and your assigned teacher to complete and submit the Registration Form, together with the Consent Form. You may expect to receive the registration outcome from SUSS within seven working days after the registration closing date. It is also the responsibility of your Team and your assigned teacher to follow up with SUSS if you do not receive the registration outcome.
- 2.6. Your registration must be submitted with the consent forms no later than 11.59pm, 15 June 2026 (“Closing Date”). The date/time stamp on your submission will be used as the official submission date/time of your registration. Proof of submission is not proof of receipt.
- 2.7. SUSS may, at its sole and absolute discretion, extend the Closing Date. SUSS reserves the right to disregard or accept registrations received by it after the Closing Date. No amendments may be made to any registrations (including the member composition of any Team) after the Closing Date without the written consent of SUSS.

3. Camp Details and Rules

- 3.1. The Camp will run from 8.45am to 5.15pm on 25 July 2026 at SUSS Campus.
- 3.2. The Camp will comprise of learning workshops, and a quiz competition at the end.
- 3.3. The quiz competition will consist of two rounds:
 - **Preliminary Round:** Multiple-choice questions.
 - Each team will answer multiple-choice questions within a stipulated time.
 - Points will be awarded for the correct answers.

- The top eight teams who scored the highest points will progress to the Final Round.
 - **Final Round:** Multiple-choice questions.
 - The top eight teams will answer multiple-choice questions within a stipulated time.
 - Points will be awarded for the correct answers.
 - The top three teams who scored the highest points during the Final Round will be awarded trophies.
 - **Winning Team**
 - The team that scored the highest points during the Final Round will be crowned the SUSS Law & Youth Camp Quiz Champion of 2026.
- 3.4. Topics for the quiz competition will include Singapore's legal journey and values reflected through Singapore's legal system, civil practice, criminal law, family law and current legal affairs.
- 3.5. Prize winners will be announced, and the awards ceremony will take place after the Final Round. At least one member of the Team must be present at the awards ceremony.
- 3.6. You will comply with all instructions, directions and timelines that may be provided by SUSS with respect to the administration and conduct of the Camp.
- 3.7. SUSS reserves the right to change the date, time and location of the Camp due to technical or organisational needs or reasons beyond the reasonable control of SUSS by announcing such changes on the [Event Page](#).

Scoring System

- 3.8. Each multiple-choice question will carry a pre-determined score for both the Preliminary and Final Rounds.
- 3.9. The Organising Committee (comprising of SUSS School of Law (SLAW) members) reserves the right to modify, amend, or change the rules of the competition, if necessary, to ensure the smooth running of the competition, and fair play. The decisions of the Organising Committee will be final.

Time Management

- 3.10. In the Preliminary Round and Final Round, each team will be given an allocated time to answer all the multiple-choice questions.

- 3.11. In case of ties, additional tie-breaker questions and/or oral presentations may be used to determine the winner.
- 3.12. The decision of the Organising Committee on the winning teams will be final.

Equipment and Costs

- 3.13. Your participation in the Camp is at your own risk and expense. Each team must bring at least one smartphone, tablet or laptop. You are solely responsible for (a) procuring all hardware including laptop, software and other equipment; and (b) all costs and expenses associated with participation in the Camp.
- 3.14. SUSS will only be responsible for providing electrical outlets (for electrical devices) and internet connectivity to participants of the Camp, which are subject to availability and limitations imposed by third party service providers.
- 3.15. SUSS will provide refreshment and lunch during the Camp.

Prizes and Certificates

- 3.16. All prizes, including the prizes available and the eligibility for prizes, are determined by SUSS in its sole and absolute discretion. SUSS reserves the right at any time to change the prizes available or eligibility for prizes, including substituting any prize with other items.
- 3.17. The receipt of prizes is subject to availability (including relevant sponsors having provided the relevant prizes and/or funding as anticipated by SUSS).
- 3.18. If a prize is unclaimed by any winning team within one (1) month from the conclusion of the Camp, SUSS may in its sole and absolute discretion, forfeit the prize entirely and/or select an alternate team as the winning team to receive the prize.
- 3.19. All participants of the Preliminary Round that did not qualify for the Final Round will receive certificates of participation.
- 3.20. The top eight teams participating in the Final Round will receive certificates of merit.
- 3.21. The top three teams participating in the Final Round may receive trophies in addition to their certificates of merit.
- 3.22. Special awards may be given at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- 3.23. All decisions by the Organising Committee will be final.

Resolution of Disputes

- 3.24. Any disputes or grievances will be reviewed by the Organising Committee.
- 3.25. The decision of the Organising Committee to resolve any disputes will be final and binding.

Conduct During the Camp

- 3.26. You and your Team must always maintain decorum and avoid any behaviour that may disrupt the Camp.
- 3.27. Any team found misbehaving, as determined by the Organising Committee, will be disqualified from further participation in the Camp. The decisions of the Organising Committee will be final.

Disqualification

- 3.28. Your Team may, at any time, withdraw from further participation in the Camp by giving written notice to SUSS and stating the reason(s) for your withdrawal.
- 3.29. You may be immediately disqualified from participating (or further participation) in the Camp if SUSS in its sole and absolute discretion determine that:
- (a) your submissions, oral or otherwise, (i) contain any element or content that is malicious, corrupt, inappropriate or offensive; (ii) violates the terms of use of any social media service, website, mobile application or any other platform used; (iii) infringes the intellectual property rights of any third party; (iv) violates any applicable law; or (v) violates or does not comply with these Terms and Conditions or (vi) contravenes any law or regulations;
 - (b) you have engaged in any one of the following: (i) verbal abuse of another participant or SUSS' staff; (ii) inappropriate touching or harming of another participant or SUSS' staff; (iii) breach of these Terms and Conditions or any other agreement entered into in connection with the Camp; (iv) compromising (or attempting to compromise) the spirit, integrity or legitimate operation of the Camp, including by cheating, or by committing fraud in any way; or (v) where continued participation may affect your health or personal well-being
 - (c) you have behaved unethically.
 - (d) you have failed to adhere to the rules or regulations;
 - (e) you have misconducted yourself;
 - (f) you have provided false information during registration; or
 - (g) you have been deemed by the Organising Committee to be unsuitable to be part of the Camp.

3.30. In exercising its rights of disqualification against you, the Organising Committee may, in its sole and absolute discretion, determine whether to disqualify your entire Team or any one or more members of your Team. If SUSS only disqualifies certain member(s) of your Team, the remaining member(s) not disqualified may elect to continue participating in the Camp without the disqualified member(s), and without the right to replace any disqualified member(s). The decisions of the Organising Committee will be final.

4. Intellectual Property and Licensing

4.1. You will retain ownership of any intellectual property created by you for the Camp.

4.2. In consideration of your participation in the Camp, you grant to SUSS and its industry partner(s) for the Camp (collectively, the “Licensees”), a non-exclusive, transferable, perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free right and licence to use, modify, reproduce, distribute and create derivative works (or have others exercise such right and licence on its behalf) of all intellectual property (including copyright in any source or form), whether or not for the licensees’ business or operational purposes. For the avoidance of doubt, the ownership of all intellectual property comprised in any derivative created by or for a Licensee will vest solely in that Licensee.

4.3. In consideration of your participation in the Camp, you grant to the Licensees, the right to publicly display photographs, digital or otherwise, or recordings of you and the work created by you during and in connection with the Camp.

5. Warranties

5.1. You hereby represent, warrant and covenant that all data and information provided by you is complete and accurate and that your registration and participation will not constitute or encourage conduct that may give rise to civil liability or otherwise violate the law, including the legal rights of third persons.

5.2. You represent, undertake and warrant that you have the requisite rights, licenses and consents to grant the licence in Clause 4 to the licensees; in the manner contemplated in Clause 4 or where such use, modification, reproduction, distribution or creation would require a Licensee to seek the consent of a third party; and you will not infringe the intellectual property right or other proprietary right (including confidential information or trade secrets) of any third party.

6. Disclaimers and Limitation of Liability

6.1. The Camp and any services or materials provided by SUSS and its representatives in connection with the Camp, are made available on an “as is” and “as available” basis.

- 6.2. SUSS and its representatives disclaim all representations, conditions and warranties of any kind, whether express, implied or otherwise, in relation to the Camp and the services or materials provided in connection with the Camp. SUSS further disclaims all liability in respect of the Camp, to the extent permissible by law. Notwithstanding any part of these terms, SUSS and its representatives reserve the right to discontinue, terminate or postpone the Camp at any time, in its sole and absolute discretion, without prior notice to you, and without incurring any liability to you.
- 6.3. Taking part in the Camp is without warranties of any kind by SUSS and its representatives. While every care is taken by SUSS and its representatives in the registration and running of the Camp, SUSS and its representatives will not be liable for any loss or damage:
- (i) that you may incur arising from any inaccuracy or incompleteness in, or errors or omissions in the registration and running of the Camp;
 - (ii) resulting from any delay in the operation or transmission, communications failure, Internet access difficulties or malfunctions in equipment or software; or
 - (iii) arising or resulting from the conduct or the views of any person who is involved in the registration and running of the Camp. To the fullest extent permitted by law, SUSS and its representatives do not warrant and hereby disclaim any warranty as to the accuracy, correctness, adequacy, fullness, reliability, timeliness, non infringement, title, merchantability or fitness for any particular purpose of the contents and materials of the Camp.
- 6.4. SUSS and its representatives will also not be liable for any damages or loss of any kind caused as a result (whether direct or indirect) of taking part in the Camp, including but not limited to any damage or loss suffered because of reliance on the contents, materials and the running of the Camp.
- 6.5. In no event will SUSS and its representatives be liable to you for any special, indirect, incidental, consequential damage of any nature whatsoever, including any loss of profits, loss of revenue, contracts, anticipated savings or business, pure economic loss, loss or corruption of data, loss of opportunity and/or expectation loss. To the extent that SUSS and its representatives may be liable to you, its aggregate liability to you, whether in contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise for any and all losses, damage or liabilities caused or arising from any breach, failure or default in performing any of its obligations (whether arising under these terms or at law), and regardless of the number of claims, will not exceed the aggregate sum of S\$100.

7. Indemnities

- 7.1. You hereby agree that SUSS and its representatives will not be liable to you in any manner whatsoever for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, consequential or exemplary damages or

other legal remedies whatsoever arising from or in connection with your registration and participation in the Camp and any breach by SUSS and its representatives.

- 7.2. You hereby agree to indemnify, defend and hold SUSS and its representatives harmless from and against any and all liability and costs incurred in connection with any claim arising from or in connection with your registration and participation in the Camp and any breach by any person, any breach by you of any rules, regulations or terms and conditions of the Camp, or any of the foregoing representations, warranties and covenants including without limitation costs on a full indemnity basis.
- 7.3. You will cooperate as required by SUSS and its representatives in the defence of any claim. SUSS and its representatives reserve the right at our own expense to assume the sole defence and control of any matter subject to indemnification by you and you will not in any event settle any matter without our prior written consent.
- 7.4. In the event of any breach of these Terms and Conditions by you, or any act or omission by you which results in a breach, you will indemnify, keep indemnified and hold SUSS and its representatives harmless from and against all actions, proceedings, claims, demands, loss, damages, costs, legal costs and other expenses of any nature which may be made or brought against or suffered or incurred by SUSS and its representatives, whether directly or indirectly.

8. Personal Data

- 8.1. Your personal data will be collected in the course of your participation in the Camp, including during the registration process and the taking of photographs or other recordings during the Camp. SUSS will process your personal data in accordance with its Privacy Statement which can be found at <https://www.suss.edu.sg/privacy-statement>.
- 8.2. You consent to SUSS' use of your personal data in connection with the Camp, including the use of your name, publication of your photographs or recordings on such media platforms that SUSS may from time to time determine for the purposes of promoting or reporting on the Camp without additional compensation, notification or permission, unless prohibited by law.
- 8.3. You agree that SUSS has complete ownership of all pictures, video recordings, audiotapes and the like which may contain your likeness, image and/or voice, including the entire copyright, and SUSS may use them for any purpose deemed as appropriate in connection with the Camp. These uses include, but are not limited to, reproductions, advertisements, promotional videos, educational materials, and illustrations in any medium now known or later developed including the internet. You release SUSS from any and all claims which arise out of or are in any way connected with such use.

9. Third Parties

- 9.1. Your participation in the Camp may require you to accept or enter into other agreements with third parties (e.g. content and/or service providers). These third parties are not SUSS' agents and SUSS and its representatives are not responsible for their actions or omissions. These Terms and Conditions will not in any manner affect your agreements with these third parties.

10. General Provisions

- 10.1. Clauses 3 to 10 will survive the conclusion of the Camp or the termination of these Terms and Conditions.
- 10.2. These Terms and Conditions form the entire agreement between the parties in relation to the Camp and supersede any other representations or arrangements relating to the Camp.
- 10.3. The invalidity, illegality or unenforceability of any part of these Terms and Conditions will not affect the validity, legality and enforceability of other parts. A waiver of a party's rights will be in writing and will not prevent the party's further exercise of the same or any other right.
- 10.4. No third party will have any right to enforce or enjoy the benefit of these Terms and Conditions under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 2001.
- 10.5. These Terms and Conditions will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore. In the event of any dispute arising out of or relating to the Camp or these Terms and Conditions, parties agree to submit the dispute for mediation at the Singapore Mediation Centre (SMC) in accordance with SMC's Mediation Procedure in force for the time being. The mediation will take place in Singapore in the English language and the parties agree to be bound by any settlement agreement reached. Should mediation be unsuccessful, parties agree to submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Singapore Courts.

11. Amendments

- 11.1. The Organising Committee reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations of the Camp at any time. Changes will be communicated to participants as soon as practicable. We suggest that you check our [Event Page](#) periodically.
