

SUSS Day 2026

Participation Terms and Conditions

The **SUSS Day 2026 event (“Event”)** is organised by **Singapore University of Social Sciences (the “Organiser”)**.

By registering for the Event, attending or participating in the Event, and/or using the Event website, you acknowledge and agree to these Terms and Conditions to the extent applicable to you. Registered participants are contractually bound by these Terms and Conditions. All persons attending the Event, including accompanying family members, friends and other guests (“Guests”), are required to comply with the applicable conduct, safety, venue and operational requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions as a condition of entry to and continued attendance at the Event.

The Organiser reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Any such amendments shall take effect upon publication.

A. REGISTRATION

1. Registration must be completed via the official online Event registration form.
2. Registration is personal to the participant, is not transferable unless otherwise approved by the Organiser, and is subject to verification by the Organiser. A confirmation email will be issued upon successful registration.
3. Participation in the Event is subject to any eligibility requirements specified by the Organiser. Participants under the age of 18 should attend with, or obtain the consent of, a parent or legal guardian, unless otherwise approved by the Organiser.

B. PARTICIPANT CONDUCT AND SAFETY

1. Participants must comply with all instructions, safety requirements, and directions issued by the Organiser and all applicable laws.
2. Participants voluntarily attend and participate in the Event at their own risk, including the ordinary risks associated with participation in the activities they choose to undertake.
3. Participants are expected to behave in a respectful and appropriate manner at all times. Harassment, discrimination, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.
4. Where the Organiser permits participants to attend the Event with Guests, the participant shall ensure that such Guests are made aware of, and comply with,

the applicable conduct, safety, venue and operational requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions and any lawful directions issued by the Organiser and its representatives, the booth operators or relevant authorities.

5. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to or require any participant or Guest to leave the Event where the conduct of such participant or Guest is deemed by the Organiser to be unsafe, inappropriate, disruptive or otherwise inconsistent with these Terms and Conditions.
6. Participants are responsible for the security of their own personal belongings. The Organiser accepts no responsibility for any loss of or damage to personal property except where such liability cannot be excluded by law.

C. DISCLAIMERS

1. The Event and any related services or materials are provided on an “as is” and “as available” basis.
2. The Organiser makes no representations or warranties of any kind, whether express or implied, to the extent permitted by law.
3. The Organiser reserves the right to modify, postpone or cancel the Event or any part of it at any time, in its sole and absolute discretion, without prior notice to you.
4. The Organiser shall not be responsible for delays, interruptions, cancellations or changes arising from circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, severe weather, public health emergencies, industrial disputes, governmental actions, venue closures or failures of utilities or communications.

D. PERSONAL DATA AND PRIVACY

1. By registering for the Event, you agree that the Organiser may collect, use and disclose your personal data for the following purposes:
 - (a) processing and administering your registration and participation;
 - (b) communicating with you regarding the Event;
 - (c) processing payments, where applicable;
 - (d) responding to your queries;
 - (e) obtaining feedback;
 - (f) sending information on future events organised by the Organiser, subject to your preferences indicated in the registration form; and
 - (g) the purposes set out in Paragraph E.

2. The Organiser may disclose your personal data to its agents, service providers and/or partners for the foregoing purposes.
3. All personal data will be handled in accordance with applicable laws, including the Personal Data Protection Act 2012, and [SUSS' Privacy Statement](#) and [Personal Data Protection Notice](#).
4. You may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting **the Organiser's Data Protection Officer at dpo@suss.edu.sg**. Withdrawal of consent will not affect any prior collection, use or disclosure of your personal data.

E. PHOTOGRAPHY, AUDIO AND VIDEO RECORDING

1. The Organiser or its authorised representatives may capture photographs, audio and/or video recordings during the Event.
2. Any collection and use of photographs, audio or video recordings of you will be subject to your consent as indicated in the registration form.
3. Where consent has been provided in the registration form, the Organiser may use your name and any photographs, video recordings, audio recordings, and/or other media containing your likeness, image and/or voice, for purposes of documenting, promoting or reporting on the Event.
4. Such use may be made across media platforms as determined by the Organiser, and may include (without limitation) reproductions, advertisements, promotional videos, educational materials, and other communications in any format now known or later developed, including online platforms. You acknowledge that no additional compensation, notification, or further permission shall be required for such authorised use.
5. Participants who do not consent will be reasonably accommodated where practicable. However, the Organiser does not guarantee that such participants will not be incidentally captured in group or background recordings.
6. Participants acknowledge that accompanying Guests may also be incidentally captured in group or background recordings during the Event.

F. INDEMNITY AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

1. You agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Organiser against any actions, proceedings, claims, demands, losses, damages, costs, legal costs and other expenses of any nature, which may be made or brought against or suffered or incurred by the Organiser, whether directly or indirectly, arising from your breach

of these Terms and Conditions or your negligent, unlawful or wilful acts or omissions in connection with the Event.

2. The Organiser shall not be liable for any special, indirect, incidental or consequential damages, including but not limited to loss of profits, revenue, contracts, anticipated savings or business, pure economic loss, loss or corruption of data, loss of opportunity and/or expectation loss.
3. To the extent permitted by law, the Organiser's total liability to you shall not exceed **S\$100**, whether arising in contract, tort (including negligence), or otherwise.

G. THIRD PARTIES

1. Your participation in the Event may require you to accept or enter into other agreements with third parties (e.g. content and/or other service providers) involved in the Event. These third parties are not the Organiser's agents and the Organiser is not responsible for their actions or omissions. Any arrangements with such third parties are solely between you and the third party.

H. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. These Terms and Conditions, together with the registration form, constitute the entire agreement between you and the Organiser in relation to the Event and supersede any other representations or arrangements relating to the Event.
2. The provisions of these Terms and Conditions which by their nature are intended to survive the conclusion of the Event or the termination or expiry of these Terms and Conditions shall continue in full force and effect, including (without limitation) Paragraphs C, D, E, F, G, and H.
3. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect. Any waiver of a party's rights shall be in writing and shall not prevent the party's further exercise of the same or any other right.
4. No person who is not a party to these Terms and Conditions shall have any right to enforce any provision under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 2001.
5. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Singapore.
6. Any disputes arising out of or in connection with the Event shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Singapore Courts.
